That the Executors of the late Ralph Firbank Esq do pay to Messrs. Houlder Bros & Co the sum of £260 with interest at 5% per annum from 5<sup>th</sup> December 1882 to date of payment.  
That the proceeds of the Cement damaged & sold belong to the Executors of the late Ralph Firbank Esq.
