

James Watt & Andrew Aitken Judges Arbiters in the
Cause Dalziel Contra Baxter & Hood.

Give sentence & decern as follows, 1st It appears ^{ing} by
the Consent of all parties that Robert Hood smith
did furnish the whole of the Iron work charged in his
Acc^t of the 6th Feby 1769, that the same was applyed
to the use of s^d Dalziel & Coy, & the prices thereof
appearing reasonable they decern the said
Dalziel & Coy to pay to the said Hood the sum
of £42.11.11 being the full of his Charge
Arithmetical Errors excepted

Secondly It app^s The said Judges arbiters being of
Opinion, fully & Clearly Convinced that the whole
wood & workmanship of the small mill, the cutting
Engine & flattening machine ~~ought to have been~~
could be furnished with ^{reasonable} profit at the sum of
£67.19.11 they decern the said Dalziel & Coy
to pay to the said David Baxter the aforesaid
sum in full for these articles they

thirdly It appearing there being an account
of other wood & work furnished by the said Baxter
(for various uses) of the value of which the said arbiters
cannot completely Judge tho it appears to be overcharg
they ordain the said Dalziel & Co^s to pay Baxter the
sum of £18.1.2 for full payment of the same
acc^t

fourthly, the Arbiters find the Lying axle tree of
the Cutting engine to be insufficient, & ordain
the said Dalziel, ^{at his own cost} to provide a piece of oak of
a proper size for said axle tree & another for the
bridle that supports it; they also ordain the
said Baxter at his own cost & Charges to make
fashion & fix for use the said lying axle with
its wheels & trundles & also to fashion & put
in the said Bridle with every thing thereunto
belonging in a proper & workmanlike
manner to be judged of by the said Arbiters

fifthly they ordain Dalziel to deliver to Baxter
for his own use such wheels & trundles with their iron
work as have been made for giving motion to the
Cutting engine or fluting mill & are now useless
for the same

Lastly they ordain the above sums or the
Balances of them remaining now unpaid to be
paid immediately after the said lying axle tree shall
be declared compleatly & properly finished as
above specified they also ordain the said
Parties mutually to discharge & cancell and settle
all manner of Agreements, Acts, or Claims now
subsisting between them on this affair declaring
the above mentioned sums to be in full
